The City Council has endorsed the “Road Diet” concept for the Fifth Street Corridor. This includes reconfiguration to one vehicle lane and one bicycle lane in each direction, with left turn pockets or a two-way left turn lane. The Council has also directed that staff consult with advisory commissions, neighborhoods, and bicycle and business interests on evaluation metrics to assess the performance of the project after implementation.
