Project Goals and Objectives:

Goal 1: Improve the function of bicycle, pedestrian, and vehicular connections between the campus and downtown.

Objective 1a: Improve the east-west bicycle and pedestrian connection from D Street to campus (along First Street, 3rd Street, and along the arboretum).

Objective 1b: Improve north-south bicycle and pedestrian connections from downtown to the arboretum, including a connection from D Street to the arboretum and along A Street.

Objective 1c: Improve the First and A Street intersection zone function.

Objective 1d: Recommend feasible shuttle opportunities to link the Mondavi Center, Future Hotel/Conference Center and Fine Arts Departments with the Downtown area.

Goal 2: Improve campus/downtown identity and wayfinding, creating a unified experience linking UC Davis and the City of Davis.

Objective 2a: Improve the campus edge identity and campus/downtown gateways, including enhancements to the First and A Street intersection.

Objective 2b: Improve wayfinding and identity recognition between Downtown and the UC Davis arts core area.

Objective 2c: Explore the identity and wayfinding function of the Arboretum.

Objective 2d: Explore the possible shuttle as a unique source of identity.
