What kinds of new housing opportunities should be made available in Davis?

To address this question, the Davis City Council has initiated a General Plan / Housing Element update and appointed a 15-member Steering Committee to lead the update process. The Steering Committee represents many different elements of and viewpoints in the community. The update will focus on creating the City's next Housing Element to accommodate State housing requirements through June 2013 and locally projected housing needs for Davis through 2010. The primary focus of the Steering Committee will be to review and prioritize potential sites for residential development using City General Plan policies, City Council goals, and regional "smart growth" principles.

As part of this update, the city is inviting members of the community to weigh in on what factors should be used when considering potential sites for housing, while also gaining input on which sites should even be evaluated for housing. This will be an informal open house style meeting to allow the public to raise questions and comment on what factors are of interest to them and what sites could potentially accommodate housing. City Staff and the Steering Committee invite the public to participate in this process.

Regular meetings of the Steering Committee are typically held the second and fourth Thursday night of the month at the Police Department (2500 Fifth Street) and are open to the public. Two more Community Workshops will be held; it is estimated that the second workshop will take place in mid/late September and the third in early/mid December.
