



## COMMUNITY OPEN HOUSE MEETING



### CrownCastle/NewPath DAS Network Proposal

The City of Davis is holding a community outreach meeting, in anticipation of a full application submittal for a city-wide wireless communication network proposed by CrownCastle International (formerly NewPath Networks). Interested members of the public are invited to attend the open house to learn more and to provide input on the proposal. City staff and applicant representatives will be present.

The open house meeting will focus on the proposed sites, changes that have been made since the pre-application review, and will provide information on the application review process. Site-specific information will be available at the meeting.

**DAS Network Design:** The proposed network would consist of approximately 25 sites with antennas located on existing street light poles or joint utility poles (PG&E poles). For the City Street Light poles, a typical design would extend the existing pole height approximately 10 feet and consist of antennas enclosed within a cylindrical casing (16 inches diameter x 72 inches high) as well as possible flush-mounted antennas lower on the pole. Ground equipment will also be located at each site. Specific designs and heights vary by location. Project information, photosimulations and details for each site will be available at the meeting and will be made available on the City web site at: <http://cityofdavis.org/cmo/newpath.cfm> by May 20th.

**Open House Format:** City staff and project representatives will be available. No formal presentation is scheduled. You may stop by at any time during the open house to view materials, ask questions, and provide comments.
