



**RESOLUTION NO. 38-10
IN SUPPORT OF THE CITY OF DAVIS' REQUEST
TO BE CONSIDERED AS A PILOT COMMUNITY
FOR THE GOOGLE FIBER FOR COMMUNITIES PROJECT**

WHEREAS, Google has announced an initiative to install ultra high speed broadband networks in a test community or communities; and

WHEREAS, Google has issued a Request for Information (RFI) by March 26, 2010 from communities desiring to be considered as a pilot location; and

WHEREAS, Davis students, residents, businesses and organizations would benefit from this improved infrastructure; and

WHEREAS, Davis, home to the University of California, Davis and a technically savvy and active population with a history of trying new and innovative ideas, is well poised to utilize additional capacity in broadband service; and

WHEREAS, improved Internet accessibility would provide new and expanded opportunities for Davis Joint Unified School District (DJUSD) educators to educate and students to learn; and

WHEREAS, participation in the Google pilot project would provide DJUSD with new opportunities to address the need of students and families affected by the digital divide; and

WHEREAS, many community groups and organizations have already expressed interest in responding to Google's Request for Information; and




