RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF  
DAVIS CALLING A SPECIAL ELECTION TO BE HELD IN  
THE CITY ON TUESDAY, NOVEMBER 8, 3005, FOR SUBMISSION TO THE  
VOTERS OF A MEASURE AMENDING THE GENERAL PLAN TO CHANGE THE  
LAND USE DESIGNATIONS FOR THE COVELL VILLAGE PROPERTY AND  
ESTABLISHING THE COVELL VILLAGE BASE LINE PROJECT FEATURES  
AND DIRECTING THE CITY CLERK TO SPECIFY THE  
DEADLINE FOR SUBMISSION OF ARGUMENTS FOR  
AND AGAINST THE MEASURE

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DAVIS DOES HEREBY RESOLVE AS  
FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Pursuant to the laws of the State of California relating to special elections, there shall be, and there is hereby called and ordered held in the City of Davis, County of Yolo, State of California, on Tuesday, November 8, 2005, a special municipal election of the qualified electors of the City of Davis, for the purpose of placing on the ballot the following measure:

Shall Resolution No. \_\_\_\_\_, amending the Davis General Plan to change the land use designations for the Covell Village property from agriculture to residential and commercial uses, as set forth in the Resolution and establishing the Base Line Project Features for development of the Covell Village Project be approved?

A full and complete copy of Resolution No. \_\_\_\_\_ is attached hereto as Exhibit 1 and incorporated herein.

Section 2. Said election shall be held on November 8, 2005. In all particulars not recited in this Resolution, said election shall be conducted as provided by law for the holding of municipal elections in the City. Said election shall be consolidated with all other elections to be held within the City on November 8, 2005.

Section 3. The City Council hereby directs the City Attorney to prepare an impartial analysis of the measure in accordance with section 9280 of the Election Code showing the effect of the measure on existing law and the operation of the measure.

Section 4. Arguments for or against said measure shall be filed with the City Clerk of the City of Davis. The City Clerk shall fix the dates for submittal of arguments as provided for in section 9286 of the Election Code.

Section 5. Rebuttal arguments may be submitted as provided for in section 9285 of the Elections code of the State of California. The provisions of said section 9285 are hereby adopted and shall apply to this election.
