Describe the difference in allocating CDBG funding to Salaries and Wages vs. Consultant/Contract Services.

CDBG funding for salaries and wages goes directly to covering temporary part-time staff costs. These temporary part time staff provide one-on-one support services for individuals with disabilities in our standard recreation programs. Support is provided in day camps, gymnastics classes, swimming lessons, dance classes, art classes, and many more.

The Consultant/Contract Services funds allocated from CDBG is given to Pine Tree Gardens. We contract with Pine Tree Gardens to provide financial assistance to their clientele (individuals with mental illness) in support of their recreational pursuits. Primarily, the CDBG portion of the money is spent on memberships to Davis Athletic Club to encourage exercise and healthy living. The additional \$2,000 listed in other sources on the Grant Application Budget Summary is money that the city gives to Pine Tree Gardens to use for trips and classes with the purpose of enhancing recreational experiences.
