Project Title: Transportation from Davis to Adult Day Health Care in Woodland

### **1. What are prospects, obstacles and challenges to having an adult day health program in Davis?**

The town of Davis is in need of an adult day program (without the health component and the health piece is too dependent on Medi-Cal). I think the town is perfect for an adult day program that offers up to 9 hours a day of social model respite for Davis citizen's. The main issue is simply the initial funds for program start up.

### **2. In the View of Yolo Adult Day Health, what is the best location, venue and partnership to form a program in Davis?**

I think a potential partnerships include housing developments looking to include an attractive community piece. Also, residential care facilities such as Covell could be. I have spoken with them however they are limited in adequate space. Regarding locations, I feel it is important to consider environment in terms of safety meaning that a busy street or urban busy setting would not be good. Church settings can be good with often the only problem related to sufficient accessible toilets. Davis Senior Center vicinity can also be nice as caregivers may be actively involved in Center activities while loved one in adult day program. I have also spoken with the planners thinking about a new "Covell Village" and have suggested they consider a combination adult/child day care center. Hope this is useful. I am more than anxious to talk at anytime about a potential Davis site.
