The following bats will be restricted from *ALL* City of Davis Softball Leagues:

For *ALL City of Davis Coed Leagues*: In addition to *all* the bats listed above, all other multi-walled, “high performance”, half-and-half, and composite bats will be restricted. All bats must be approved by the League Coordinator prior to use in league. Approved bats will be marked with a City of Davis bat approval sticker. Any bat not showing an approval sticker will not be allowed and will be treated as an illegal bat. Additional bats may be added to these lists at any time at the discretion of the league coordinators.

**For all bats:** The handle knob may not be covered with any substance (tape, end cap cover, etc). No bat may rattle when shaken. **ALL BATS MUST BE ASA APPROVED (ALL BATS MUST HAVE THE ASA STAMP).**

Any player caught using an illegal bat will be ejected immediately. Any player using an illegal bat a second time, at anytime during the season, will be ejected from that game and be suspended for a minimum of four additional games. Umpires may remove a bat from a game, even if it is not on the list, if they feel the bat is inappropriate for that league. Players may protest the removal of the bat at that time and a ruling will be made within 24 hours whether the bat will be allowed in the league or not.

As per ASA rules, any player found utilizing or bringing to the ballpark any altered equipment will be suspended for a minimum of two years from all ASA play. In addition, every player on that person’s team may be subject to a one year probation.
