

Parks & Community Services Expands Offerings Online

Just in time for great picnic weather, the Parks & Community Services Department online class registration and facility schedule page now includes information about reservable park picnic areas. Reservation of these areas is available for a per-hour charge ranging from \$13.50 to \$58 per hour, plus a deposit ranging from \$20 to \$75, depending on group size and

recreation classes. Parks & Community Services personnel encourage households to use online registration, which enables more efficient application processing.

Future plans include adding reservation calendars for the city's soccer and softball fields, for which online facility reservations eventually may be added. Our software developer responds to suggestions from Davis residents and staff members about ways to improve the department's parks and recreation online offerings.
