POLITICAL CAMPAIGN SIGN REGULATIONS

Public Property:

You may not place political campaign signs on public property. Public property includes sidewalks, curbs, street lamp posts, poles, benches, hydrants, trees, shrubs, bridges, electric lights, power or telephone wire poles or wire appurtenances, street signs, traffic signs, and any other public object.

Private Property:

Commercial or Industrial Property:

- Signs may not exceed 18 square feet per street frontage

Residential Property:

- Signs may not exceed 6 square feet
- A landlord or lessor may not prohibit a tenant from posting political signs. A resident may post a sign in a window, on a balcony, on the door, from the yard, or outside a wall of the premises leased by the tenant in a multi-family dwelling.

ALL SIGNS MUST COMPLY WITH THE FOLLOWING RULES:

- Signs should be placed so that they cannot be easily blown over or knocked down.
- Signs may not obscure or cover another political or lawful sign which was previously there.
- Signs may not project above the height or beyond the sides of a building.
- Signs may not block access to any door or window of a building.
- Signs must be legible and include the name, address, and phone number of the responsible party or the sign may be registered with the City Clerk's Office.
- Signs must be removed within 5 days following the election related to the sign.
- Signs placed unlawfully shall be removed by the responsible party.
