

EVERYTHING YOU WANTED TO KNOW ABOUT THE 6TH GRADE PARTY (and a few things you didn't).

Congratulations on your last day in elementary school and welcome to City of Davis Teen Programs!

This is a lot of information. Yes, we want you to read it!

What is the 6th Grade Party?

This is a super fun event for recently graduated 6th graders. In addition to music and dancing, there will be food, laser tag, a bounce house, foosball, video games, lawn games, board games and card games (we really like games). This event does not require a date (yuck!) and is meant to celebrate the commencement (woo-hoo!). Participants should dress nice but not overly dressy. No slow songs are played, sorry teens! Parents, we got your back!

When is it?

Thursday, June 9 from 6:30 – 9:00 pm

Where is it?

Veterans Memorial Center, 203 East 14th Street in Davis

How much does it cost?

Tickets are \$12 each

Tell me everything about purchasing tickets!

Tickets will go on sale Tuesday, May 31 beginning at 8:00 am.

Online: If you would like to purchase a ticket online please visit us at community-services.cityofdavis.org (click the Online Registration button on the right). To purchase your ticket online you must have an active online account. The activity number is 750200 (but remember tickets won't be available for purchase until May 31).

In Person: If you would rather not deal with technology, just come into our office (we are located at 23 Russell Blvd) and you can purchase your ticket in person. You must have a 2015/2016 City Liability Waiver on file.

You can only purchase tickets for 6th graders who are in your household. There will be no paper tickets for this event. Everyone who is registered will be on our Guest List—so you don't have to worry about losing your ticket. Tickets are non-refundable and non-transferable. There are a limited number of tickets available and we have sold out the last several years so make sure to buy your ticket early!

Should I bring money to the 6th grade party?

There will be food and drinks available to purchase. We will have a photo booth at the event and for \$5 participants can have a photo of them and their friends printed on site to take home with them! Teens should bring extra money if they wish to purchase food, drinks or photos during the party.

Who's running this show?

The City of Davis Community Services has been hosting 6th graduation for over 20 years! Our staff is hired because they are responsible, enthusiastic and genuinely enjoy working with youth. All of our staff is background checked and fingerprinted. For this event we not only use Teen Programs staff but we also use summer camp staff so if you have been to our camps, you may see some familiar faces. Staff will be spread through the facility ensuring participants safety and leading games and activities. All utilized spaces of the facility (the MPR, game room, courtyard, bathrooms and lobby) will be continuously monitored throughout the event.

What are the rules?

So glad you asked! These rules apply to all special events hosted by Teen Programs. Please take a minute to read through them.

- Participants will not be allowed to enter the activity more than 30 minutes after the event begins unless accompanied by an adult or leave before the event concludes unless accompanied by an adult.
- School dress code will be followed and enforced; no tube tops, midriff-bearing tops, sagging pants, bandanas, excessively short skirts/shorts, offensive language or images on any clothing or hats. Be classy!
- No alcohol, tobacco or drugs of any kind, including paraphernalia.
- No firearms, knives (including pocket knives) or anything that could be used as a weapon.
- No verbal and/or physical violence allowed.
- No grinding, moshing, freaking or any other kind of inappropriate dancing will be permitted.
- Be respectful of your peers, staff and the facility.
- City of Davis is not responsible for any lost, stolen or damaged property.
- Consequences for not following teen program rules could include a phone call to parent/guardian, early removal from the event and/or suspension from future programs.

What else should I know?

Teens are released at the end of the party at 9:00pm. If your teen needs to leave prior to the end of the event, they will need to be checked out by an adult. Please arrange beforehand with your teen exactly where you will meet them as there will be many teens and parents trying to find each other.
