Roll Call and Introductions: Meeting called to order at 4:30 p.m.

1. **Agenda** – The agenda was approved unanimously by consensus.

3. **Commissioner Communications** – S. Winton stated the City Clerk will hold open the recruitment for the vacant Public-at-Large Member until mid-November. The City Council will select Commissioners on December 1st.

5. **Public Communications** – J. Youmans introduced himself and stated he has applied for the vacant Public-at-Large position.
6. **City Council/Commission Joint Meeting Follow-up**-The Commission agreed that the joint meeting was very productive and useful in providing direction to the Commission.

ASUCD Student/Police Relations Sub-Committee-Kara Rodenhiser is chairing this sub-committee. C. Simvoulakis will contact her and get an update.

UC Davis West Village project-G. Sandy stated it is moving forward and they are working on additional grants for sustainability efforts

Commission Sustainability Sub-committee- M. Lachowicz has completed the research on establishing goals and will now begin analyzing each goal.

Safe Party Initiative- A. Ercia stated they are working on assessing parties hosted by student groups. They are interested if they are providing food, conducting drinking games, etc.

Davis Neighbors' Night Out-S. Winton stated there were 143 parties, 15 hosted by students. They received many positive comments. The City is conducting a survey of party hosts and will share the results with the Commission. G. Sandy noted that the University won a Gold Award from the Council for the Advancement and Support of Education (CASE) in its Public and Community Relations category.

2010 Picnic Day-The Picnic Day Committee is discussing last year's event and how they can address concerns of trash, early bar hours and the parade route.
