SUBJECT: Resolution Authorizing the City Manager to Enter Into Agreement with First Five Yolo to Administer the Quality Enhancement Program for Fiscal Years 2010-2015

Recommendation

Approve the attached Resolution authorizing the City Manager or his designee to enter into Agreement No. CFC8-804A with First Five Yolo to administer the Quality Enhancement Program to provide educational services to child care providers and to perform all necessary actions to administer this Agreement for fiscal years 2010-2015.

Fiscal Impact

The City will receive \$216,117 for the administration of the First Five Yolo Quality Enhancement Program (QEP) in fiscal year 2010-2011. The funding will continue to cover all expenses related to the staffing and administration of this project including funds to support citywide overhead. No matching City funds are required.

Council Goals

Goal 1: Fiscal Stability - The proposed action supports the Council's goal of fiscal stability by maximizing the use of County funds to provide high quality city services that meet the needs of local residents. This program also improves the quality of child care in our community making it easier for parents to find quality child care.

Background and Analysis

Child Care Services has received funds from First Five Yolo to enhance the quality of child care in our County for over 8 years. This grant allows Child Care Services to continue to provide supportive services, training and resources to child care providers who care for infants through pre-schoolers. The goal of this program is to increase the quality and access to child care for families in Yolo County.

RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT WITH FIRST FIVE YOLO FOR ADMINISTRATION OF THE CHILD CARE QUALITY ENHANCEMENT PROGRAM

WHEREAS, child care services are a critical need identified by the City of Davis; and

2. The City Manager of the City of Davis or his designee is hereby authorized to approve minor modifications to the documents after consultation and approval of the City Attorney.
