SUBJECT: Fifth Street Corridor Improvements, Evaluation Measures

At its April 27, 2010 meeting, the City Council directed staff to consult with the Bicycle Advisory Commission, Safety and Parking Advisory Commission, neighborhoods, bicycle advocacy groups, and business interests on evaluation metrics to assess the performance of the project after implementation of the corridor reconfiguration. Staff anticipates a one-year evaluation period for the first phase of the improvements. This would allow the City to evaluate operation through the seasons and reflect the learning curve that is necessary for the road users.

The evaluation measures will include:

- Before and after trip counts for all modes on Fifth Street, side streets, and on the adjacent corridors including Third, Fourth and Eighth Streets.
- Before and after collision rates and collision severity on Fifth Street, side streets, and on the adjacent corridors including Third, Fourth and Eighth Streets.
- Measuring intersections' Level of Service/delay throughout the corridor.
- Corridor travel time before and after the implementation.

Staff solicited input from the Old North Davis and Old East Davis Neighborhood Associations, the Downtown Davis Business Association, Davis Bicycles! and the Chamber of Commerce. Following is a summary of the comments received:

- Speed measurements after the implementation.
- Exit interview with businesses leaving downtown after the implementation.
- Residents' survey after the implementation.
- Treat all trip modes equally (vehicles, bicycles and pedestrians).
