

# City of Davis Community Emergency Response Team

The Davis Fire Department has begun its 2011-12 Community Emergency Response Team (CERT) training program. An orientation meeting was held September 22 and training is planned to begin in early October.

The CERT program trains citizens on the topics of disaster hazards that may impact their community, and instructs them in basic disaster response skills, such as fire safety, light search and rescue, team organization, and disaster medical operations. Using the skills gained in the classroom and during exercises, CERT members can assist others in their neighborhood or workplace following a disaster or other emergency event when professional responders are not immediately available to help.

Program participants will receive 20 hours of training over eight sessions and is provided free of charge. Participants must be 18 or over.
