

This map has been prepared so you can easily locate the type of play area you would like to visit within the City of Davis. There are over 60 play areas throughout the city. Many of the facilities shown on this map have play areas for “tots” and primary school-aged children. Tot lot play areas are for children 2-5 years of age while primary play areas are fun for children 6-12. Perhaps you would like to try out a variety of locations and find you and your children’s favorite.

All of the parks are maintained by the City of Davis Parks and Community Services

Department. Parks Division staff visually inspect each park daily for safety and potential safety hazards. They also perform an annual detailed inspection for equipment integrity, vandalism, surfacing and other potential problems. The City is also responsible for renovation of play apparatus and areas to meet current safety and accessibility standards. For example, beginning



in 1990, the City began the use of engineered wood fiber and rubber matting as floor space material. These were found to be safer for children than other previously used materials and were required by state and federal regulations. Federal laws require the City to make playground areas accessible to the disabled and safe for all users.

Please remember to supervise your children when they are playing in park areas.

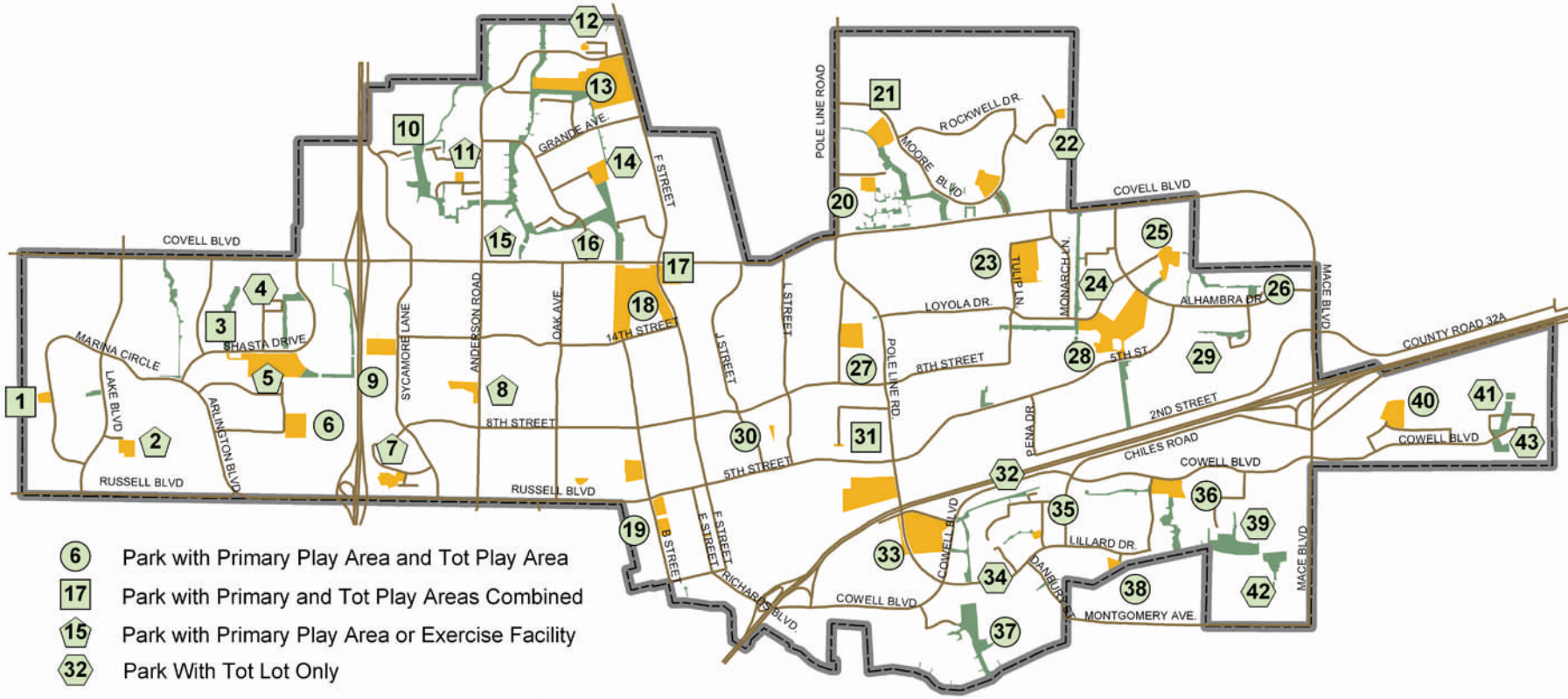
