**RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DAVIS
ADOPTING THE INTEGRATED PEST MANAGEMENT POLICY**

WHEREAS, the purpose of the Integrated Pest Management Policy is to ensure that all city operations within Parks and General Services, Open Space and Public Works and their contracted services that manage pests or vegetation on city property do so in an environmentally sensitive manner while addressing public health, safety, economic and aesthetics requirements; and

WHEREAS, the Integrated Pest Management Policy was reviewed by the Natural Resources Commission on September 22, 2008, the Open Space Commission on October 6, 2008, and the Recreation and Parks Commission on October 16, 2008; and

WHEREAS, implementation of the Policy will occur throughout the city's parks and greenbelts, and trials will be conducted on alternative methods of pest control such as solarization and "green" pesticides incorporated with known effective practices like irrigation management and mulching, pursuant to the following schedule:

- Winter 2009: Mace Ranch Park and Central Park
- Spring of 2009: Arroyo Park, Walnut Park and Community Park
- Summer 2009: Pioneer Park, Slide Hill Park, Chestnut Park, Sandy Motley Park
- Fall 2009: Westwood Park, Barovetto Park, North Star Park and Sycamore Park
- Winter 2010: Covell Park, La Playa Park, Oak Grove Park, Oxford Circle Park, Putah Creek Park
- Spring 2010: Redwood Park, Robert Arneson Park, West Manor Park, Willowcreek Park
- 2011 through 2014: Remaining parks, ball fields and greenbelts

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Davis, as follows:

1. The Integrated Pest Management Policy, attached as Exhibit 1, is hereby approved
2. The City Manager or his designee is authorized to allocate appropriate procedures as needed to implement the Integrated Pest Management Policy
