ALL PARKING PERMITS EXPIRE
AUGUST 31, 2012

COMMUTER PERMITS

Commuter permits allow Downtown employees to park all day without time limits in designated on and off street parking areas.

"X" and "D" permit hangers are **transferable to other vehicles** and are required to be displayed on the rear view mirror of commuter's vehicles.

"X" permit stickers are non-transferable and are required to be affixed to the left rear bumper of commuter vehicles.

An employee who leaves employment from the Downtown Core Area must surrender their commuter parking permit to their employer.

Employers: you are responsible in ensuring against the improper use or display of commuter permits, and should notify the Davis Police Department of employees who fail to surrender their permits. Misuse may result in suspension of an employer's parking permit privileges.

"X" COMMUTER PERMITS (Hangers & Stickers)

Allow parking in designated on and off street parking areas in the periphery of the Downtown Core Area.

"X" Commuter Permits may be purchased by commuters employed in the Downtown Core Area.

"D" COMMUTER PERMITS (Hangers)

Allow parking in designated spaces in the 1st/Fst Parking Structure located at 101 F Street.

"D" Commuter Permits may be purchased by commuters employed at businesses in **Parking Assessment District No. 3** – the area bounded by 3rd St (south side) on the north, 1st St on the south, Dst (east side) on the west, and the railroad tracks on the east.

- ✓ Completed commuter parking permit application
- ✓ California drivers license
- ✓ Proof of employment, including, but not limited to: paycheck stub, employee ID card, letter verifying employment(On letterhead with the business owner or managers signature)
- ✓ Cash, personal check or money order (No ATM or credit cards accepted)

Additional Requirement when Purchasing "X" Sticker Permits:

- ✓ For each vehicle: current California Department of Motor Vehicles (DMV) or out of state registration document with the employee's name printed on it. (a proof of insurance card is not acceptable)

Additional Requirement when Purchasing "X" Sticker Permits:

- ✓ **For each vehicle:** photocopy of current California Department of Motor Vehicles (DMV) or out of state registration document with the employee's name printed on it. (a proof of insurance card is not acceptable)

RESIDENTIAL & VISITOR PARKING PERMITS

RESIDENTIAL PERMITS (Stickers)

Residential Permits allow residents to park on-street in a preferential parking district.

Residential Permits are non-transferable and are required to be affixed to the left rear bumper of residents' vehicle.

Pricing \$12.00 Each

Availability: H, N, P, Q, R, S, T, U, W and X parking districts. ("N" permits limited to 1 sticker or placard per address; 2nd permit may be purchased beginning Dec 1.)

VISITOR PERMITS (Placards)

Visitor permits allow visitors to park on-street in a preferential parking district.

Visitor permits are transferable (to other vehicles) and are required to be displayed on the front driver-side dashboard of the visitors' vehicle. ("N" visitors' permits may also be used by residents.)

- ✓ Visitor permits are to be used only for visiting the residence to which the permit is assigned and only for the duration of the visit. *
- ✓ Visitor permits are to be used within 100ft of the side lot line of the residence to which the permit is assigned. *
- ✓ Visitor permits are not to be used for longer than 14 consecutive days (72 consecutive hours in the "H" parking district.)
* Not applicable in the "N" parking district

Pricing \$12.00 Each

Availability: H, N, P, Q, R, S, T, U, and W parking districts. ("N" permits limited to 1 sticker or placard per address; 2nd permit may be purchased beginning Dec 1.)

RESIDENTS

You are responsible in ensuring against the improper use or display of visitor permits. Misuse may result in suspension of parking permit privileges and/or citations (\$225 minimum) being issued to both the purchaser and user of an unlawfully used permit

BEFORE YOU BEGIN

- ✓ **Homeowners / Businesses** may apply in person or by mail
- ✓ **Renters must apply in person**
* Businesses located in the "X" or "D" parking districts are only eligible to purchase Commuter permits (see reverse side).

Additional Information:

- ✓ **Use The Checklist Below** to ensure that you have met all of the application requirements.
- ✓ **New Vehicles** without DMV issued license plates will be issued temporary parking permits, which can be exchanged for residential permits at no extra charge once license plates have been received.

VISITORS

Use your emergency flashers while retrieving a visitor permit from your host. Permits must be clearly displayed to be valid

APPLYING IN PERSON

All Applicants:

Please bring the following items to the Davis Police Department

- ✓ Completed Residential Parking Permit application
- ✓ California Drivers' License or other government issued photo identification
- ✓ Cash, personal check, or money order (no ATM, debit or credit cards)

Additional Requirement When Purchasing Residential Permits:

- ✓ **For each vehicle:** current California Department of Motor Vehicles (DMV) or out of state vehicle registration document with the resident's name printed on it. (a proof of insurance card is not acceptable)

Additional Requirement For Renters:

- ✓ Current lease, rental agreement or contract
- ✓ **For month to month lease terms only:** Lease and current utility bill (PG&E, AT&T, Comcast, etc.) with the resident's name and service address (in the permit district) printed on it.

Additional Requirement When Purchasing Residential Permits:

- ✓ **For each vehicle:** current California Department of Motor Vehicles (DMV) or out of state vehicle registration document with the resident's name printed on it. (a proof of insurance card is not acceptable)

REMINDER:

Residential parking permits do not override posted "**NO PARKING ANYTIME**" or Street Cleaning Restrictions.

VOIDED PARKING PERMITS

When residents move out of a preferential parking district, their residential and visitor permits will be **Voided**. Continued use of voided permits will be deemed misuse and may result in citations (\$230 minimum) being issued to the user of an unlawfully used permit.
