To obtain a copy of a police or accident report, contact our Records Division. Requests must be in writing and there is a 10-day response period to these requests, allowed by law. Release of report information is under strict guidelines of the Public Disclosure Law and the Privacy Act. Our Records Division also provides fingerprinting services. There are processing fees for these services.

## Citizen Police Academy

The Citizen Police Academy provides an opportunity for citizens to become familiar with the day-to-day operations of the Davis Police Department. This 10-week evening program will enable participants to gain a better understanding of the procedures, guidelines, responsibilities, and demands that guide the Davis Police Department and its officers through their operations.

Academy topics include an overview of the Police Department, Laws of Arrest, Search, and Seizure, Traffic Enforcement, Narcotics and Gangs, SWAT Operations, Explosives Demonstration, Use of Force Issues, Crime Prevention, Community Policing, Investigations, High Tech Crimes, K-9 Demonstration, and more.

Youth Intervention Specialist Trease Petersen manages the juvenile diversion program, which is the official halting of formal juvenile justice proceedings against a first time juvenile offender. It encourages voluntary participation in community service and various other programs relative to the needs of the juvenile and family. She also works with Davis Joint Unified School District to manage school truancy and co-teaches Parent Project, parenting classes for strong willed or out of control teens, enhancing parental control and skill building. ## Davis Police Cadet Program

The City of Davis Police Cadet Program is a volunteer position for both males and females beginning with seventh graders. The program exists to provide youth with basic experience, training, and insight into law enforcement.

Cadets receiving training in a variety of police duties including criminal law, patrol procedures, police radio procedures, report writing, crime prevention, traffic school, traffic enforcement, public relations, basic first aid and other areas.

## RAD Training

The RAD program is a comprehensive course for women. It begins with awareness, prevention risk reduction and avoidance, while progressing on to the basics of hands-on defense training.
