Methamphetamine Lab Found In Davis Neighborhood

An investigation into narcotic sales by a parolee led Officers from the Yolo Narcotics Enforcement Team (YONET) to an apartment on Alvarado Avenue in Davis where a search warrant revealed a methamphetamine lab.

On November 18th, 2009 at approximately 1800 hours, Officers from the Davis PD, YONET, Woodland PD Gang Task Force, Yolo County Gang Task Force and the California Department of Corrections arrested Brandon Lee Whittmore, (34 years old from Davis) in the parking lot of the complex. Whittmore attempted to flee in his vehicle but was apprehended after Officers blocked his vehicle from leaving. Two other suspects arrested were Carrissa Nicolay (28 years old from West Sacramento) and Carrissa Dawson (24 years old from Woodland).

Officers searching Whittmore's apartment found evidence of narcotics sales, loaded firearms and a methamphetamine manufacturing lab. In response to this discovery, the Yolo County Environmental Health Department and the California Bureau of Narcotics Enforcement (BNE) Clandestine Lab Team responded to safely remove the lab. The apartment was later deemed to be uninhabitable by the BNE until it can be determined that no dangerous fumes or chemicals are present.
