## **Two Female Victims Assaulted By Unknown Suspect Cases 11-639, 11-640**

In the evening hours of February 16<sup>th</sup>, two female victims were attacked by an unknown male suspect. The assaults were two separate incidents that happened approximately two hours apart. Davis Police believe these crimes are related due to the similar suspect descriptions.

The first incident occurred at approximately 6:00 PM on Fifth Street in a light industrial area east of Pole Line Road. The adult female victim was walking on the sidewalk when an unknown male came out of the bushes and grabbed her. She pushed the assailant away while yelling for him to leave her alone. The suspect stopped his advance and casually walked away. The victim described the suspect as a white male, approximately 35 years old, blue eyes, bald, clean shaven, about 5'11 in height with a muscular build, wearing a blue T-shirt shirt and jeans.

The second incident took place around 8:00 PM in the area of Drake Drive and Sycamore Lane. An adult female victim was walking on Drake Drive when an unknown suspect jumped out of the bushes. He assaulted the victim by grabbing her leg and buttocks. The victim fought back by pushing the suspect away. The suspect stopped and fled by running eastbound on Drake Drive toward Sycamore Lane. The victim described the suspect as a white male, between 30-40 years old, approximately 5'6-5'8 in height, 170 pounds, skinny build, with white thinning/balding hair. The suspect was wearing a blue T-Shirt, blue shorts, white tennis shoes, and white socks.

The Davis Police Department is investigating these incidents and anyone with information is encouraged to call (530)747-5400. Due to the similar suspect descriptions and time frame, Investigators believe these two crimes may have been committed by the same perpetrator.
