Davis Man Investigated For “Peeping” With a Camera Case 11-2167

On May 31 2011, at approximately 2:40 AM Davis police officers responded to the area of 707 Sycamore Lane for a call of a suspicious male. A resident at the complex reported an unknown male was lurking around a specific apartment with a camera. The apartment was later determined to be occupied by a 20 year old female.

Upon arrival officers detained Chad Jones, a 27 -year-old male out of Davis. The suspect initially tried to flee from arriving officers but was later pulled over in his vehicle leaving the scene. Camera equipment was found in Mr. Jones' car which contained images suggesting he was videotaping and taking photographs of the 20 -year-old victim.

Mr. Jones was subsequently arrested for obstructing police officers and the case is being submitted a for charges of photographing the victim without her consent and peeping to the Yolo County District Attorney. Chad Jones was booked at the Davis Police Department and released on a notice to appear in court.
