Residential Burglary Activity

In the last 5 days the Davis Police Department has investigated 8 separate residential burglaries occurring in West, Central, and South Davis.

Central Davis

On September 18th, two separate residential burglaries were reported, both occurring in Central Davis. One burglary occurred in the morning (between 8:45 am and 9:00 am), while the other occurred in the afternoon (between 4:00 pm and 5:00 pm). In one case, the perpetrator made entry through an unlocked sliding door. In the other case, the perpetrator made entry through an unlocked front door while the victim was at home in her bedroom. Laptops were taken in both cases.

South Davis

Between September 18th and September 19th two separate residential burglaries occurred in South Davis. In one case, the perpetrator was arrested and the victim's property was recovered after an alert resident notified the police of the crime and provided a description of the stolen property. An officer patrolling the area spotted the perpetrator and took him into custody without further incident.

In the second case, while the victim was on vacation, the perpetrator made entry by breaking a side-yard window. Personal property was taken from the residence.

West Davis

Between September 17th and September 21st four separate residential burglaries were reported in West Davis. Three of these burglaries occurred while the resident victims were at home. These burglaries occurred between 6:00 am and 1:00 pm and the victims were able to provide the following physical descriptions of the perpetrator, which may or may not be of the same individual:

- Young male adult
- Between 5'6"-5'9"
- Thin build
- Brown wavy hair

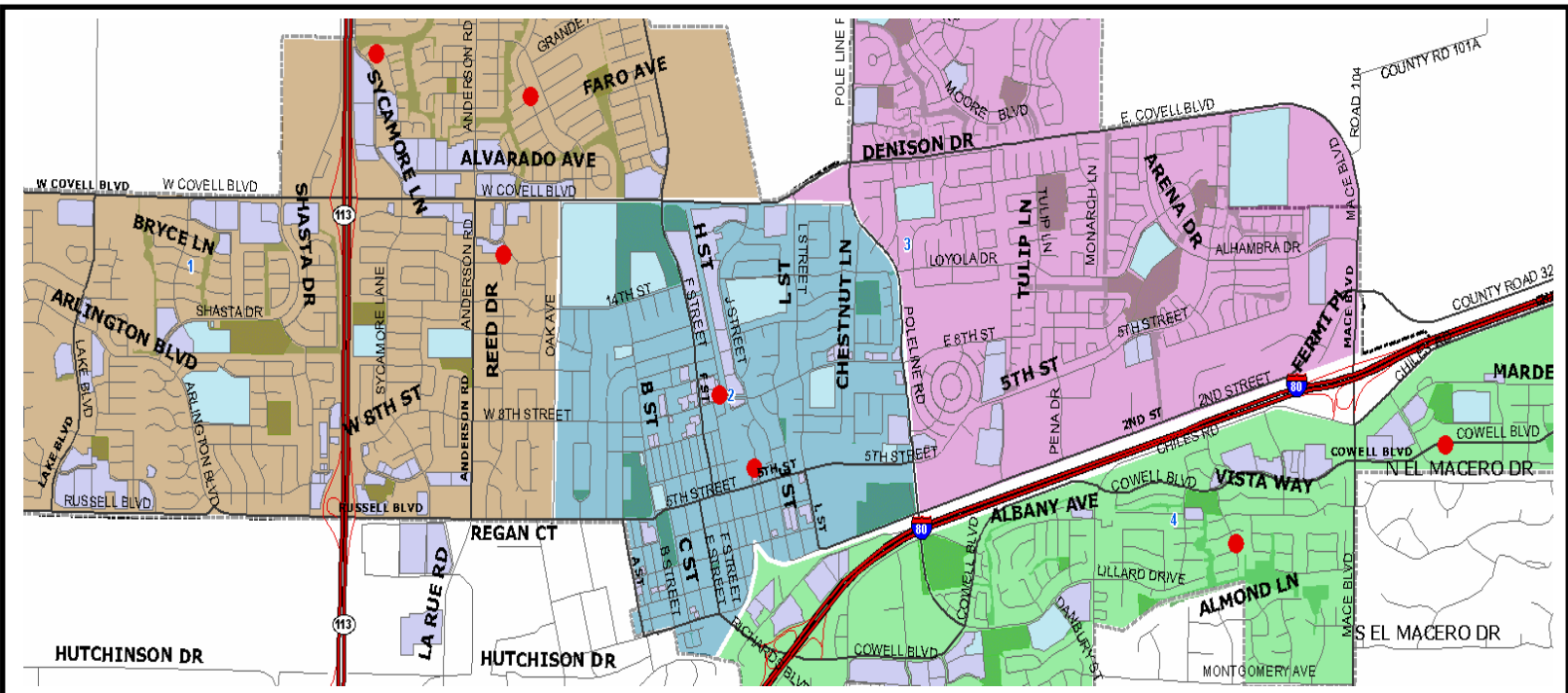
