This project will construct a grade separated bicycle and pedestrian crossing of East Covell Boulevard. It will connect from the existing greenbelt between Mace Ranch and Davis Manor, just west of Carmelo Lane, to the existing path on the north side of East Covell Boulevard at the east side of Wildhorse.

The grade separated crossing is part of the overall bicycle system as shown on the City's General Plan since 1986.

The input received at this open house will be used to finalize the Design Alternatives Report. Preliminary alternative designs will be posted. Your comments are encouraged.

The tentative schedule is to present the Design Alternatives Report and recommended alternative to the City Council for approval this fall. Final design would occur this winter and spring. Another public meeting is planned during the design process. Construction is tentatively planned for summer of 2005.
