**SUBJECT:** Streets that are Being Considered for the Green Waste Containerization Project

### **Recommendation**

Support focus on streets outlined in this report for inclusion in the pilot study.

### **Fiscal Impact**

None at this time

### **Background**

The last element in developing the pilot green waste containerization program is to determine the streets that will participate. Attached is a map depicting the focus areas. The criterion has been to choose arterials or minor arterials with bike lanes and heavy bike and auto traffic. In order to capture east/west traffic, two collector streets, Villanova and Eighth Streets are also wrapped into the pilot.

Using these streets, residential, apartment and some commercial accounts will be affected. This is important to the pilot in that we will get experience on different aspects of green waste collection that will help better assess containerization.

As indicated in prior presentations and reports, a mass mailing is going out in August, speaking to proper pile placement and introducing the pilot program. In September, customers in the pilot will get another letter reviewing the program elements and timeline. The participant letter will also note the date and time of the September BAC and NRC meetings, which offers them opportunities to express their comments or concerns.
