Subject: iBIN Recycling Program

Dear Apartment Manager,

The City of Davis has been awarded grants from the California Department of Conservation to implement an innovative recycling program at multi-family properties in Davis—the iBIN Recycling Program.

The iBIN Recycling Program builds on a pilot program started fall 2006, where 750 apartment units in Davis were given their own recycle bins. These iBINs (in-apartment recycling bin) make it easier for residents to collect and transport recycling to recycling carts in their community's trash enclosure.

Thanks to the grant funding, the City can now extend the pilot program to all apartments in Davis.

The iBIN Recycling Program will not cost you anything and may even help you save money! In Davis, you pay for your trash hauling, but recycling service is free. If you can increase your recycling and decrease the amount of trash you produce, you can reduce your garbage service and save money.

The iBIN Recycling Program is set to begin sometime in 2008. Enclosed is more detailed information about the program.

The City of Davis Public Works Department Recycling Program will be hosting workshops to answer questions and familiarize apartment managers and apartment management companies with the program. Workshops will be held on December 11 from 12:00-1:00 pm and December 13 from 6:30 to 7:30pm in the City Council Chambers at City Hall, 23 Russell Blvd.

In order to deliver the correct number of iBINs to your property, I need to know your apartment property name, address and the number of units. If you have several properties, please provide the names, addresses and # of units for each property. If you cannot attend one of the workshops, please contact me with this information.
