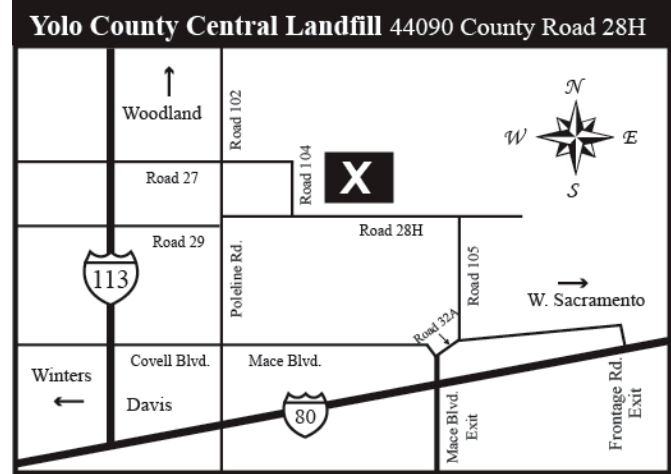


2010 Yolo County Household Hazardous Waste Drop Off Days

Limit of 125 pounds or 15 gallons due to Department of Transportation Regulations

Electronic waste (e-waste) is recycled at the Yolo County Central Landfill at no cost **everyday**. This includes: televisions, monitors, computer components, microwaves and other small electronics. **Also accepted daily: Latex paint, batteries, motor oil & filters.**

Unacceptable Items

Small Business

Small Businesses, including farms and ranches may haul no more than 220 lbs. or 27 gal. of hazardous waste

These items CANNOT be placed in the trash, but can be recycled for FREE at the following locations:

Batteries

Alkaline, lithium and rechargeable batteries can be recycled for free at these collection sites in Davis:

- Davis Senior Center, 646 A St.
- CVS Pharmacy, 1550 E. Covell Blvd. and 1471 W. Covell Blvd.
- Rite Aid, 655 Russell Blvd. and 2135 Cowell Blvd.
- Hibbert Lumber at 5th & G Sts.
- Davis Ace Hardware at 3rd & G Sts.

PLEASE NOTE:

All batteries must be sorted by type (alkaline, lithium and rechargeable) BEFORE you bring them to a site to be recycled. Place each type into a separate plastic baggie for easy handling.

The following sites in Davis also collect rechargeable batteries:

- Radio Shack, 634 G St.
- Kragen Auto Parts, 1681 Research Park Dr.
- City Hall, Finance Department, 23 Russell Blvd.

Electronics

Electronics, such as TV and computer monitors, cannot be put in the trash. The Yolo County Central Landfill will accept these items at no charge* during normal business hours. Acceptable items include:



* a fee is required for disposal of appliances

- computer monitors
- fax machines
- televisions
- keyboards
- printers
- microwaves
- typewriters
- stereos
- VCR's
- CPU's
- and more!

Cell Phones

Cellular phones can be recycled at any cellular phone store, and many non-profits collect them for recycling. See www.call2recycle.org for locations where both cell phones and rechargeable batteries are accepted.
