



# These items CANNOT be placed in the trash, but can be recycled for FREE at the following locations:

## Batteries

Residents can bring alkaline, lithium and rechargeable batteries to these collection sites in Davis for free and safe disposal:

- Davis Senior Center, 646 A St.
- CVS Pharmacy, 1550 E. Covell Blvd. and 1471 W. Covell Blvd.
- Rite Aid, 655 Russell Blvd. and 2135 Cowell Blvd.
- Hibbert Lumber at 5th & G Sts.
- Davis Ace Hardware at 3rd & G Sts.

### PLEASE NOTE:

All batteries must be sorted by type (alkaline, lithium and rechargeable) BEFORE you bring them to a site to be recycled. Place each type into a separate plastic baggie for easy handling.

Radio Shack at 634 G Street accepts rechargeable batteries only.

## Electronics

Televisions, computer monitors and microwaves are illegal to throw away in the trash. The Yolo County Central Landfill will accept these and other electronic waste items for free every day during normal operating hours (a fee is required for disposal of appliances such as refrigerators and washers). Accepted items include:



- televisions
- computer monitors
- microwaves
- cell phones
- fax machines
- printers
- stereos
- keyboards
- vacuum cleaners
- toasters
- typewriters
- VCR's
- CPU's
- CDs
- DVDs
- VHS tapes
- cassette tapes
- and more!

## Used Motor Oil and Filters

Used motor oil and filters can be recycled for free at the locations listed below. These sites will pay 40¢ per gallon for used motor oil.

- Jiffy Lube, 1625 Research Park Dr. (916) 375-1155
- O'Reilly Autoparts, 1681 Research Park Dr. (530) 753-6755
- SpeeDee Oil Change & Tune-up, 2000 F St. (530) 753-1633

- Call ahead to confirm hours and quantity of oil accepted.
- Do not leave oil or filters at drop-off locations after hours.
- Do not mix motor oil with antifreeze, brake fluid, or other liquids or solids.
- Bring contaminated oil and other automotive fluids to a Household Hazardous Waste Drop-off event (see the other side of this flier).

How often are you changing your car's oil? Needing to change your car's oil at 3,000 miles is a myth. Auto makers now are recommending oil changes at 5,000 to 10,000 miles. Check your owner's manual for more information.



## Cell Phones

Cell phones can be recycled at any cell phone store. Many non-profit organizations collect them for recycling as well. For locations where both cell phones and rechargeable batteries are accepted, visit [Call2Recycle.org](http://Call2Recycle.org).
