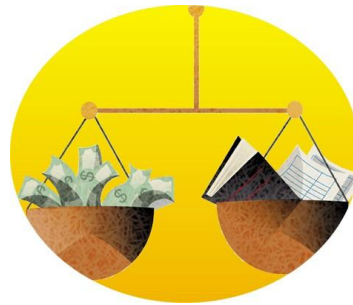


# 2004-2006 Accomplishments

## Council Accomplishments

At the December 13, 2006 Goal Setting Session, the City Council listed many of the accomplishments completed over the 2004-2006 period and reviewed the list of completed Objectives from the 04-06 Goals. These lists have been combined to provide a more comprehensive look at major accomplishments of the 2004-2006 Council.

## Fiscal Stability



1.2. Implemented a system of Quarterly Budget Updates for the City Council

1.3. Conducted a systematic review of all fees and rates charged by the city to identify subsidies and most appropriate fee structures.

1.4. Updated the budget adoption calendar

1.5 and 6.6. Established approach to review fiscal impacts of any major and significant application for growth and infill projects, including major UC Davis projects

1.6 and 4.2 Reviewed options for renewal of the parcel tax or other revenue source and developed a strategic plan (Passed a parks tax.)

# 2004-2006 Accomplishments

## Economic Development



2.1 Pursue high demand retail stores... (Took action on Second Street Crossing (Target) project. Approved retail projects at Alhambra Center and Interland. Worked with Trader Joes to find suitable location.)

2.2 Adopted a plan to redevelop Davis Manor Shopping Center. Consider rezoning. Explored inclusion in RDA. Developed specific reuse plans. Worked with neighborhood groups.

2.5. Reviewed and took action on work plan of Business and Economic Development Commission

2.7 Assisted Yolo County Visitors Bureau to attract more conferences to Davis by making city facilities more accessible.

## Public Safety



3.1. Provided a reliable public safety radio system that serves all areas of the community. Identified funds and implemented this high priority objective.

3.7 Expanded the police volunteer program to include monitoring of parks and greenbelts

## Downtown Davis

5.6 Intensified use of Boy Scout Cabin.

5.7 Completed Master Plan for Central Park/Farmer's Market

## Housing and Growth
