Russell Boulevard Green Street Demonstration Project

Public Art Opportunity

The City of Davis Civic Arts Commission, in support of City Council goals to *ensure downtown Davis remains the vibrant economic, cultural, and social center of the community, and in pursuit of environmental sustainability*, invites artists to create work to activate a public plaza and seating area in front of City Hall, located at 23 Russell Boulevard, in Davis, CA.

The entire project will showcase the effectiveness and beauty of sustainable landscape design for the community, serving as a green street model. **Selected artist proposals will** celebrate sustainability, greening-related themes, local flora and fauna, history of place, and/or the architectural themes of City Hall, and will adorn the faces of six 2' x 2' concrete seat cubes.

Application deadline – May 10, 2019 / 5:00 P.M.

Anticipated project unveiling in November, 2019.

Up to \$6,000 commission will be awarded to the selected artist or team of artists.
