Batteries

Residents can recycle single-use household batteries at these sites in Davis:

- CVS, 1550 E. Covell and 1471 W. Covell Blvd.
- Davis Ace Hardware, 3rd & G St.
- Davis Food Co-Op, 620 G St.
- Davis Senior Center, 646 A St.
- Nugget Markets, 409 Mace and 1414 E. Covell Blvd.
- Recology Davis Recycling Center, 2727 2nd St. (during buyback hours only: Mon. – Fri. 9:30 a.m. – 2 p.m. and Sat. 8 a.m. – 4 p.m.)
- Rite Aid, 655 Russell & 2135 Cowell Blvd.

Place alkaline and lithium batteries into separate plastic bags for safety.



 Save money and reduce waste by switching to rechargeable AA, AAA, C & D batteries.

Sharps Waste

Sharps (used hypodermic needles, lancets and other devices used to penetrate the skin) cannot go in the trash. Residents that have used sharps can place sharps waste in a puncture-proof container, tape the lid shut, write "Sharps Waste" on the outside of the container and bring the filled container to a location listed below for free and safe disposal:

- Recology Davis Recycling Center, 2727 2nd St. M – F 9:30 a.m. to 2 p.m. & Sat. 8 a.m. to 4 p.m.
- Yolo County Landfill, 44090 County Rd. 28H Thurs., Fri. & Sat. 7:30 a.m. to 3:30 p.m.



Unused Medications

Unused medications should never be flushed down a toilet or poured down a drain.


Prepare your medication for drop-off:

1. Remove or blackout your information on prescription labels.
2. Place pills in a clear zippered plastic bag and recycle the container. Keep liquids & creams in their original container & seal them tightly.
3. Drop off medications at these locations during pharmacy hours:
 - Kaiser Davis MOB OP Pharmacy, 1955 Cowell Blvd.
 - CVS Pharmacy, 1550 E Covell Blvd.
 - Rite Aid, 2135 Cowell Blvd.

Electronics

Residents can recycle televisions, computers, phones, printers and other electronics for free every day at the Yolo County Landfill. See the location and hours below.




 If electronics still work, consider donating them to thrift stores or selling them instead of recycling.

Household Hazardous Waste Drop-Off

Residents can bring toxic items to the Yolo Landfill for free and safe disposal every Thursday, Friday and Saturday from 7:30 a.m. to 3:30 p.m. Seniors and persons with disabilities can call 530-666-8856 to schedule a free pick-up. Accepted items include:

- Automotive products
- Batteries & paint
- Fluorescent bulbs & tubes
- Household cleaners
- Pesticides & fertilizers
- Propane and helium canisters
- Used cooking oils, fats and grease
- Used syringes

Hazardous waste disposal for businesses

Businesses may not bring their hazardous waste to any of the locations listed on this page, as these programs are specifically for residents.

However, if your business produces less than 220 pounds or 27 gallons of hazardous materials each month, you may be eligible to use the business hazardous waste program at the Yolo County Landfill. Fees apply and are based on the type and amount of material brought in.

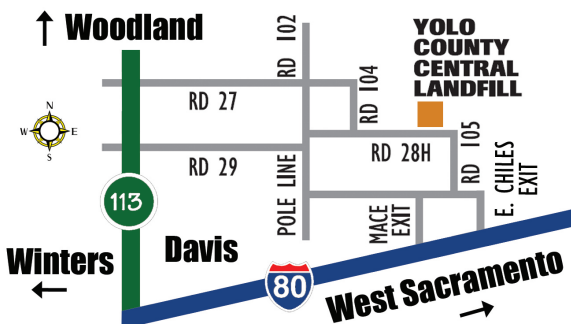

Accepted Items

- HOUSE:** Aerosol sprays • Asbestos (wet+double bagged) • Batteries • Cleaners • Cooking oil • Cosmetics-perfumes/colognes, hair products, makeup • Fire extinguishers • Fluorescent lamps • PCB light ballasts • Medications • Nail polish and remover • Mothballs • Pharmaceuticals • Sharps/needles (in container) • Toiletries- shampoos, lotions • Mercury thermometers
- GARAGE:** Antifreeze • Auto batteries • Brake and Automatic transmission fluid • Engine cleaners • Road flares • Fuel such as butane, diesel, gasoline, kerosene and lamp oil • Motor oil and filters • Power-steering fluid • Car paints
- WORKSHOP:** Flammable liquids and solids • Adhesives • Paints, stains, glazes, and varnishes • Paint thinners • Photo chemicals • Solvents, wallpaper remover, paint remover • Wood finishes • Grout, cements, caulking, sealants
- YARD:** Fertilizers • Fungicides • Pesticides including: Ant stakes, Insecticides • Pool chemicals • Propane cylinders up to 23 gallons and Helium tanks up to 5 gallons • Rodenticides • Weed killers

Limit of 125 lbs. or 15 gallons per trip per Department of Transportation Regulations

Small Business

Small businesses, including farms & ranches, may haul no more than 220 lbs or 27 gallons of hazardous waste. Small businesses wishing to dispose of hazardous waste must :

No pet pesticide products, animal meds. & No biologics (insulin) accepted in the med-project collection bins.

All "No" items are accepted at the Yolo HHW listed above.
