



Affordable Rental Housing for Students in Davis

Not all affordable housing apartments and programs can assist students. Please review the information below to help guide your housing search off campus.

Affordable housing programs define student households in the following categories:

You are an All Student Household...

if you're a single student attending school full-time, or if you live with one or more full-time students, and/or are married to a full-time student. If you are in this category, you are not eligible for most federally-funded low-income programs.

You are a Student Family Household...

if you are a full- or part-time student with children, either as a single-parent or a two-parent household. As a family, it is likely that you will be eligible for all affordable housing not otherwise restricted to a special need, as long as you qualify by income.

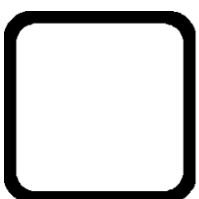
You are an Undocumented or Partially Undocumented Student Family Household...

if you are a full- or part-time student who is undocumented, or if you live in a student family household with other individuals who are undocumented. While apartment owners and managers determine their criteria regarding citizenship, apartments with federal funding are likely more restrictive.

The apartments on the other side of this flyer are organized based on their likelihood to be able to accept the household types above. Please note, you will still need to income qualify for the complex on a regular basis to be able to live there.

Housing Choice Voucher Program/(Section 8) Rental Assistance

This program cannot help all-student households because it has federal funding. The program can assist student family households and partially undocumented households based on the number of people in the family who are documented.
