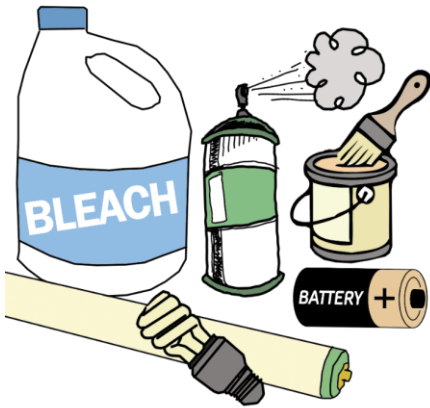


# Business Hazardous Waste

Safe disposal options through the Yolo County Central Landfill



## Does your business have hazardous waste?

- paint
- pesticides
- automotive fluids
- used oil & filters
- cleaning products
- mercury thermostats
- fluorescent bulbs
- alkaline, lithium or rechargeable batteries
- mercury containing devices
- non-empty spray cans
- solvents

**It is illegal to put hazardous wastes in the trash. They must be disposed of properly to protect human health and the environment.** Federal and State laws require all businesses that generate hazardous waste to comply with regulations for proper handling, storage and disposal.

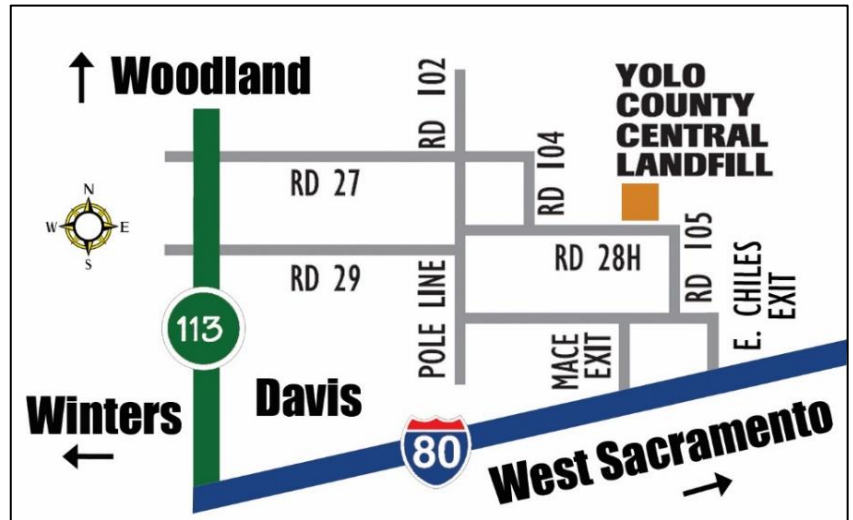
## How can your business get rid of hazardous waste safely?

Businesses may not bring their hazardous waste to weekly household hazardous waste drop-off at the landfill, as that program is specifically for residents. However, if your business produces less than 220 pounds or 27 gallons of hazardous materials each month, you may be eligible to use the business hazardous waste program at the Yolo County Landfill. Fees apply and are based on the type and amount of material brought in.

### Yolo County Landfill Business Hazardous Waste Program

**STEP 1: Have an EPA ID # ready.** If you don't already have one, you can obtain an EPA ID online at [DTSC.CA.Gov/Apply-For-Hazardous-Waste-EPA-ID-Number](http://DTSC.CA.Gov/Apply-For-Hazardous-Waste-EPA-ID-Number). If you only have universal waste you can make an appointment without an EPA ID#.

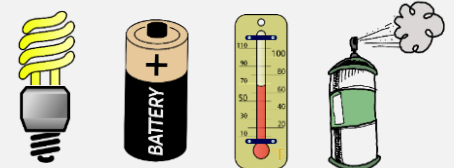
**STEP 2: Call (800) 207-8222 to schedule an appointment.** Business hazardous waste disposal is available by appointment only, so be sure to call ahead of time! Appointments are available every Friday from 9 a.m. to 2 p.m.
