


## SITE PLAN Public Art Opportunity F Street & Covell

The intersection where the public art site is located includes <u>Davis Arts Center</u> to the west, the <u>Davis Little League</u> fields to the east, and residential and commercial properties. It extends to a path in one direction that crosses over the Union Pacific freight railroad tracks operated by the **California Northern Railroad**, and in the other direction curves around the baseball fields, and under the roadway, connecting with **The Cannery**. The Cannery occupies the former <u>Hunt Wesson Plant</u> site, historically home to the production of tomato canning. The Cannery is a mixed-use neighborhood center that includes varied housing, a working urban farm, nearly 30 acres of parks and open space, and a future Market Hall commercial property.

The public art location is also immediately adjacent to Community Park, which houses the Mary L. Stephens-Davis Branch Library, North Davis Elementary School, Davis Senior High School, and the Veterans Memorial Community Center and Theatre.


Map of site and surroundings. Red line delineates the primary location for art installation:



Panoramic of site-- large retaining wall on the southeast corner of F St. and Covell Blvd.:




Facing North toward Covell on F Street, retaining wall increasing in height:
