

**RESOLUTION NO. 20-053, SERIES 2020**

**RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DAVIS DECLARING THE RESULTS AND SUCH OTHER MATTERS AS PROVIDED BY LAW OF THE SPECIAL MUNICIPAL ELECTION HELD ON MARCH 3, 2020**

WHEREAS, a Special Municipal Election was held and conducted in the City of Davis, California, on Tuesday, the 3rd day of March, 2020, as required by law; and

WHEREAS, notice of said election was duly and regularly given in the time, form and manner as provide by law; voting precincts were properly established; election officers were appointed and in all respects the election was held and conducted and the votes were cast, received and canvassed and the returns made and declared in the time, form, and manner as required by the provisions of the Election Code of the State of California for the holding of elections in general law cities; and

WHEREAS, the County Clerk of the County of Yolo canvassed the results of the election and has certified the results to this City Council, the results are received, attached and made a part hereof as Exhibit "A".

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City Council of the City of Davis does resolve as follows:

Section 1

1. The total number of ballots cast including vote-by-mail, precinct, and absentee voting ballots was 26,682.
2. The number of vote-by-mail ballots cast was 17,751.
3. The number of precinct ballots cast was 8,901.
4. The number of absentee voting ballots cast was 30.

Section 2 The Special Municipal election was held for the purpose of submitting the following measure to the electors of the City as required by the laws relating to cities in the State of California:

Measure Q – Shall Ordinance 2563 extending the existing one percent sales tax with no increase to the current rate, providing approximately \$8,600,000 annually until repealed by the voters, subject to annual review, with all funds staying local, and continuing existing funding for city services such as police, fire, recreation programs, city roads, sidewalks, bike path maintenance, and other city services, be adopted?

Section 3 The number of votes cast for and against Measure “Q” were as follows:

Section 4 The number of votes given at each precinct for and against the measure were as listed in Exhibit “A” attached.

Section 5 The City Council does declare and determine that Measure “Q” was approved by the voters and shall be deemed adopted and ratified.

Section 6 The City Clerk shall enter in the records of the City Council a statement of the results of said election, showing: (1) the total number of votes cast in the city; (2) the measure voted upon; (5) the number of votes given at each precinct for and against each measure; and (6) the total number of votes for and against each measure.
