




CITY GENERAL FUND SOURCES & USES 2021–22








CITY GENERAL FUND REVENUE TRENDS





PROCESS

Grant funds to Davis - \$19.6 million

Allocations:

- Paul's Place: \$1 million
- Healthy Davis Together: \$750,000
- Employee Furlough Salary Restoration: \$832,000
- Dept of Social Services & Housing: \$790,000
- Crisis Now Program: \$1.17 million
- City Revenue Backfill 21-21 Budget: \$2.3 million

Uncommitted funds: \$13,787,200








DISC 2022 ON JUNE BALLOT







- Council directive to focus on needs:
 - Affordable housing, homeless services, support for mental health
- Key coordination with County and other entities providing services
- Police Dept can focus on other issues



HEALTHY DAVIS TOGETHER CONTINUES WITH 1 CITY AND COUNTY FUNDING



- Ongoing UC Davis commitment
- City Allocates \$750,000 to fund program through June 2022
- County Allocates \$1 million to fund Healthy Yolo Together through June 2022
