




CITY GENERAL FUND SOURCES & USES 2022-2023









INVESTING IN CITY INFRASTRUCTURE STREETS - PAVING & STRIPING







CURRENT PAVEMENT CONDITIONS




Current Davis Pavement Conditions

Davis Streets = 57

DECISION TREE FOR BIKE PATHS



PAVEMENT INVESTMENT NEEDED

- Substantial investment in the street and bike path network (\$421.5 Million)
- Overall the network is in "Fair" condition
 - **Street PCI = 57**
 - Bike Path PCI = 50
- Existing budget (\$9M/year) is A BIG IMPROVEMENT over prior years, but is insufficient to reach target PCI
 - Street PCI will deteriorate to 56
 - Bike path PCI will improve to 59
 - Deferred Maintenance will increase to \$139.6 Million
 - By 2029, 25.5% of streets, 26.1% of bike paths will be in "Failed" condition
- City Council revenue subcommittee to explore revenue options



City of Davis Most Important Problem




Affordable housing is the predominant top-of-mind issue in Davis, followed by homelessness and public safety.
