## REQUIREMENTS FOR SECOND ADDRESSES

All addresses shall be clearly visible from the street to which they are addressed. Address numbers shall be a minimum of 4 inches in height and their color shall contrast with the material to which they are affixed.

- 1. Each addressed space shall have an all-weather path wide enough to accommodate a gurney that extends from the street to the main entrance of the unit.
- 2. All addresses must be clearly visible from the street to which they are addressed. Numbering shall be 4 inches in height, ½-inch in width, and shall be of a color contrasting to the background to they are attached (per Section 8.14.050(c) of the Municipal Code).
