## Hello Brenda –

So are you referring just to GHG thresholds? If so, yes, we suggested contacting us for more info. The thinking was that we might have some "official" adopted GHG thresholds by the time the actual analysis was performed for the project. We have had a couple issues come up that we need to resolve prior to moving forward with the adoption of any new thresholds, so we don't have anything yet. In the interim, we are recommending that you use what has been adopted by the SMAQMD. There are a couple reasons for this:

- 1. SMAQMD is an adjacent air district, and they are the only district in our region that has officially adopted thresholds
- 2. We agree with the methodology that was used to develop the SMAQMD thresholds, and we believe that our own GHG thresholds will probably look very similar (or even identical) to SMAQMD's, eventually.
