Project Description:

The City has received a revised application for the Trackside Center project, a mixed-use building proposed at 901-919 Third Street. The revised project is for a 4-story, 56,881 square-foot building with 9,100 square feet of retail space on the ground floor, 27 apartment units above with surface parking. The revised project also includes demolition of the existing structures, an outdoor plaza on the west side, and other site improvements.

This project was rescheduled from the HRMC's November 14, 2016 which was cancelled.

HRMC Review

The purpose of the HRMC meeting is to review the Historical Resource Effects Analysis (HRE) report prepared for the revised project and to provide input on the project's consistency with the Davis Downtown and Traditional Residential Neighborhood Design Guidelines. As part of their review of the original proposal, the HRMC already determined that the existing commercial buildings did not meet the criteria for listing as a historical resource.

Project issues related to planning policies and zoning will be considered as part of the required Planning Commission and City Council review which will be scheduled at a later date.
